American Singing Game

Everyone but child who is the "dog".



Dog - gie, dog - gie, where's your bone? Some - one stole it



from your home. Who stole your bo - - ne?

"Dog" (asking individual child)



Did you steal my bo - - - - ne?

Child's response.



No, I - - - - did - - - - n't.
Yes, I - - - - di - - - - d.

This song is a great singing game for children for a few reasons:

1. It's emphasis of Sol-Mi-La, which make the easiest intervals for children to hear and sing.
2. It helps children come out of their shell and learn to sing a solo.
3. It's a fun game! Children love it.

Note that it is in D major (2 sharps). This is the easiest key for young children to sing in.
